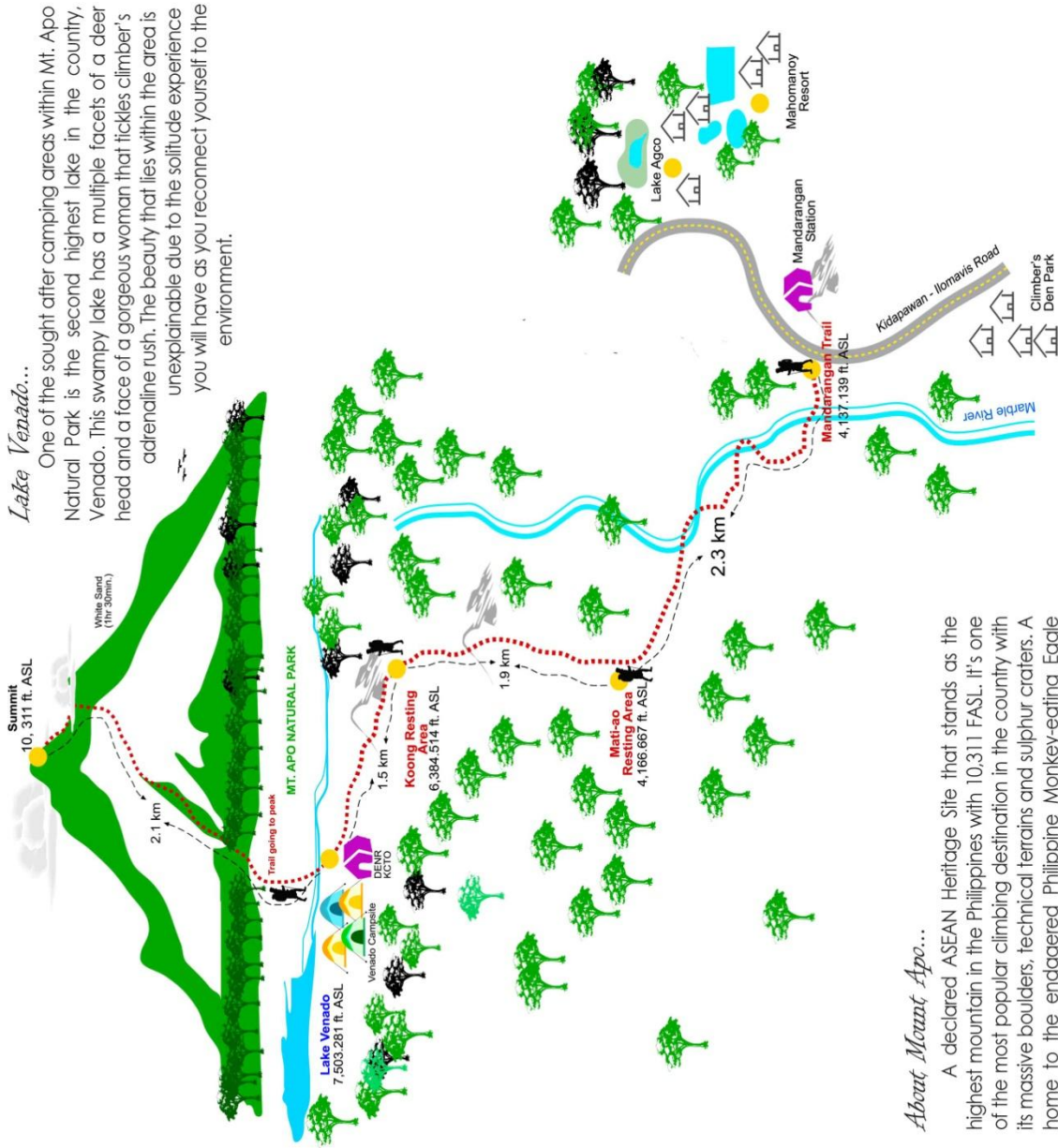

7:00am
- Arrive at Kidapawan City Travel Agencies (process the registration permit and payments)
- DAY 1**  
6:00 am
- Jump off to Mandarangan Station, Brgy. Ilomavis Kidapawan City (45min)
- 6:45 am
- Arrive at Mandarangan Station (Pre-check your receipt, registration permit and IDs at Tourism Satellite Office for verification. Check the backpack. Meet your appointed Mt. Apo Mountain Guide and Porter.)
- 8:30am
- Start hiking from Mandarangan to Mati-ao 1<sup>st</sup> resting area (2hrs walking).
- 10:30am
- Arrived at Mati-ao resting area (early lunch) 4,166.67 ft ASL
- 11:30pm
- Start hiking to Koong 2<sup>nd</sup> resting area (4hrs walking)
- 3:30pm
- Arrived at Koong resting area (6, 384.51 ft ASL)
- 3:40pm
- Start hiking to Lake Venado (3hrs walking)
- 6:00pm
- Arrived at Lake Venado Camp Site (pitch your tent with porters and get rest) 7, 503.28 ft ASL
- 7:00pm
- Dinner at Lake Venado
- 9:00pm
- Lights out
- DAY 2**  
2:00am
- Wake up and have your light morning snacks
- 3:00am
- Start hiking to summit with your Mt. Apo mountain guide
- 5:40am
- Catch the sunrise on the Peak (10,311 ft ASL) Climb seven (7) peaks of Mt. Apo and see the different beauties.
- 6:30am
- Breakfast at Mt. Apo peak
- 9:00am
- Jump off at peak going back to Lake Venado
- 11:00am
- Jump off at Lake Venado Going to Mandarangan
- Lunch at Koong
- 1:00pm
- You may drop by at the Mandarangan Station to claim your well deserved certificate and purchase some souvenirs to bring home.
